



EXISTING CAMPUS - 2008

1. HARMAN CHAPEL - Improved main entry
2. LANSDALE HALL - The building would become strictly academic in use
3. EASLEY LIBRARY - Library expansion into lower level.
4. CRUISE HALL - 94 Bed men's resident hall, ADA improvements
5. SHOTT HALL - Expanded bookstore & cafeteria use
6. RISH HALL - 102 Bed women's dormitory, lower level to serve as temporary offices
7. GREEN - Improved landscaping
8. CAMPUS HOUSES - No changes, maintenance only
9. ALUMNI & ADVANCEMENT OFFICES - No physical changes, maintenance only, use may change
10. RESIDENCE HALL - 96 Bed men's resident hall

11. ENTRY / CAMPUS PERIMETER IMPROVEMENTS - Main entry to be reconfigured for better emergency access. Perimeter fencing to be added.
12. CAMPUS AND COMMUNITY CENTER - Campus anchor building, college and community athletic and activity facility.
13. SCIENCE CENTER - The remaining fourth story of the building would be constructed for academic space.
14. RESIDENCE HALL - 3-6 Story building, 150 - 250 bed, lowest level accessed from parking lot, upper level access from pedestrian street

15. CAMPUS PARKING - Future Civics Arts parking lot
16. PEDESTERIAN STREET - Serves as the main campus pedestrian spine and allows for maintenance and emergency vehicle access.

17. ADMINISTRATION ADDITION - New location for administration, upper level would contain student study areas, meeting spaces and cafe.
18. WALKING / CART PATH - Access path to athletic fields
19. ATHLETIC BUILDING - Concessions, restrooms, athletic offices, storage & changing rooms
20. BASEBALL / SOCCER / MULTIPURPOSE FIELD - Multi-sports field for practice and intramural sports

TWENTY YEAR MASTER PLAN - 2028

21. INTERSECTION - Intersection reconfigured to improve safety and circulation
22. GREEN - New campus green, design to allow for emergency vehicle to turn around
23. LOOP ROAD - Connection of existing roads to form a campus loop road
24. OUTDOOR AMPHITHEATRE - Serves as a social gathering space for students & outdoor classroom. Design to contain half hard and soft materials.
25. PARKING - Parking spaces to be reconfigured, location for a parking deck if needed
26. RESIDENCE HALL / LEARNING CENTER - 3-6 Story building, lowest level accessed from parking lot, upper level accessed from pedestrian street
27. PHYSICAL PLANT BUILDING - Facility to house all maintenance equipment & vehicles.
28. BRIDGE - Connects main campus to athletic complex. Serves as a visual marker.
29. PROPERTY ACQUISITION - Desired property acquisition
30. COMMUTER / FACULTY PARKING - Users would walk over bridge to access campus
31. SOFTBALL FIELD - Practice / Intramural softball field, desired property acquisition
32. TENNIS COURTS - Tennis facility relocated for construction of new civics arts building
33. LAKE/RETENTION AREA - Landscaped lake to handle campus water retention needs
34. CIVIC ARTS BUILDING - Facility to serve as a campus anchor building. Uses to include art, music & theatre departments, lecture halls, theatre stage.
